Last date to file for Training and Experience Rating is **October 1, 2008**

VACANCIES: Two full-time positions and one relief position in the **Rockland County Department of Mental Health**.

For this promotion examination, eligibles can be appointed only in the jurisdiction in which they are presently employed.

SALARY: In accordance with the appropriate labor agreement.

WHAT THE JOB IS LIKE: This is professional psychiatric work permitting some latitude for independent judgment in providing professional medical and psychiatric clinic services in the Community Mental Health Center. In addition, the work involves assisting in directing and administering programs within the Mental Health Center. The work is performed under the direction of a higher-level psychiatrist, administrative division head and/or clinical director. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: You must be currently employed in the **Rockland County Department of Mental Health** and have, immediately preceding the last date to file, one year of permanent competitive class status there as a Psychiatrist I.

SUBJECT OF EXAMINATION: There will be no written or oral test for this examination. Candidates meeting the minimum qualifications will receive a rating based on an evaluation of their training and experience against the background of the duties of the position. You are, therefore, asked to include in your application a summary of all pertinent training and experience in sufficient detail so that your experience may be evaluated against the duties of the position. Your application will be rated on the following items. Please be sure your application and any supporting documents are sufficiently complete to avail yourself of as high a score as possible.

1. Do you meet the minimum qualifications? (See above.)
2. Do you have any specialized post-psychiatric residency training in Psychiatry?
3. Do you possess board certification in Psychiatry? (Copies of current license and board certification should be submitted with the application.)
4. Do you have any continuing education in the field of Psychiatry?
5. What experience do you have beyond the minimum requirement for this position that was in Community Mental Health or Institutional Psychiatry? (Note starting month and year and ending month and year as well as hours per week worked.)
6. What experience, if any, have you had in private practice? (Note starting month and year and ending month and year as well as hours per week worked.)

NOTE: A resume does not substitute for the completed application but may supplement the application. Month and year as well as hours per week of employment must be indicated. **Also include a copy of your professional license or documentation indicating eligibility for licensure.**

Candidates who submit incomplete applications or documentation may be disqualified. Additional information will not be accepted after applications have been evaluated.
